**GLOBAL URANIUM UPDATE ON TIN NEGOURAN URANIUM PROJECT, NIGER**

Toronto, ON, August 8, 2007 – Global Uranium Corp. (“Global,” a private Ontario corporation) announced today an update of its Tin Negouran uranium project located in the Agadez region of Niger, West Africa. Niger is the fourth largest uranium producer in the world.

Highlights:

- 14,978 line kilometres of airborne geophysics and radiometrics have been completed on the 2,000 km<sup>2</sup> concessions on 150 metre line spacing.
- 1,000 cup alpha track survey (Radon soil survey) completed over two known uranium occurrences.
- 5,000 metre reverse circulation drill program commenced July 30, 2007 on first target area known as the Tin Negouran deposit. This work is being completed by ESAFOR, a drilling company based in Niger.
- Borehole logging underway concurrent with drill program to define the extent and thickness of the mineralized horizon.
- Lyntek, Inc. of Denver, Colorado, engaged to provide engineering consulting services to Global for the development of the first uranium mine at Tin Negouran.

Since signing the four concession agreements with the Government of Niger, covering the known Tin Negouran deposit and surrounding area in late January, 2007, Global has undertaken an aggressive exploration and development program which included airborne and ground geophysical and radiometric surveys as well as commencing the first phase of delineation drilling on the target area known as the Tin Negouran deposit. This deposit, first discovered by a Japanese exploration team 20 years ago, is the focus of Global’s current exploration and development effort on the concessions. Global’s intention is to outline a mineable reserve and complete a scoping study, for production, by year end 2007.

In addition, an independent consultant was engaged to prepare a report in compliance with NI 43 101.

Numerous other exploration targets have been outlined using the airborne and ground exploration techniques mentioned above. It is Global’s intention to continue defining these targets with follow-up ground work and drilling.

The four concessions controlled by Global are on trend with numerous uranium deposits in this prolific area of Niger.
